Before the Event

- This is a no alcohol event.
- Your boat must be insured.
- Your boat must be able to pass a Washington State safety inspection.
- You are responsible for a safety briefing for your guests before you leave the dock.
- You are expected to provide all necessary fishing and safety gear.

Saturday, September 13th

0500 Boat and Veteran Check-in opens at Harbor Marine

- All participating boats will be numbered Numbers provided in Registration packet.
- All participants will be given the number that corresponds with their boat assignment at check-in.
- A captain and/or crew member must be present at 0500 in the check-in area to meet their designated guests. Please line up in numerical order
- There is always the possibility of last-minute changes in boat assignments due to drop outs and new participants. Please help our guests unite with their boat crew and help us make sure no one is left on the dock.
- Coffee, breakfast sandwich and lunches will be available at check-in for all boat crews and participants.
- You will be provided with free fishing licenses for you and your guests. Please turn them in at the BBQ area.
- The Media may be present so please be aware of that
- Please do not bring unregistered family members, friends or guests.

0600 Board Boats and head out to the fishing grounds!

Afternoon

1000 Fish Care Station Opens – located at the Fisherman's Memorial and haul-out area.

- We encourage you to help your guest filet their fish AFTER photos are taken.
- Bags and Ice will be provided to store and transport fish.
- Get your photo taken next to the fish care area.
- 1400 Fish Care Station closes
- 1400 BBO begins
- 1430 Program begins at Harbor Marine
 - Look for our Banners. Must have wrist band to enter. No entry for unregistered individuals.
